Correspondence and Informational Items -Upcoming Crab Feed: Commissioner Hermle shared the district didn't qualify for Golden State Risk Management's annual RMAP. He also shared GSRMA is holding Ethics and Harassment Training on April 15, 2026. Also, Katie from Golden State said nepotism addressed in the Employee Handbook is sufficient, the district doesn't need a policy. Commissioner Pollock stated the Yolo Librarian contacted her in regard to the upcoming National Night Out on August 4th. She was asking if the Yolo Fire District is going to invite the Sheriff's Department and Dunnigan Fire District to participate again this year. And if keeping the event time as last year 6:00-8:00 P.M. works for Yolo Fire District? Chief Tafoya will reach out and coordinate with the Librarian.

Update on Discuss Hiring of Full Time Firefighter and Possible Action: Chief Tafoya stated there were two internal candidates. Interviews are scheduled for Wednesday, April 8th. He will

be joined by a panel of three other fire chiefs, Knights Landing, Dunnigan and Arbuckle Fire. Possibly state date the first part of May.

Fire Chief's Report and Possible Action(s). Chief reported he attended the CSAP meeting. Discussed dangerous roads in the County with major injuries/fatalities. He will continue to attend the meetings. He also attended Yoche Dehe Fire's annual Awards Banquet. He is still working on the air truck situation. The MCI trailer is sold. He also reported Yolo County Fair has been extended 8 days. The County reviewed permitting process on Ag Exempt Buildings. Fire Districts has the option to adopt an Ordinance on Ag Exempt Buildings. The Board of Supervisors are scheduled to discuss a Countywide Inspector for Ag Exempt Buildings on April 14, 2026. He also shared Engine 8 is still experiencing pump issues. All units are scheduled to be pump tested on April 27, 2026.

Personnel Issues: Nothing further to report.

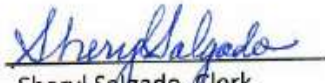
