RESOLUTION NO. 02-5

(Resolution Adopting Conflict of Interest Code Incorporating by Reference the Fair Political Practices Commission's Standard Model Conflict of Interest Code)

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code §§81000 et seq., has in the past and foreseeable future will require conforming amendments to be made in conflict of interest codes adopted and promulgated pursuant to its provisions; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") has adopted a regulation, 2 California Administrative Code §18730, which contains the terms of a standard model conflict of interest code ("Model Conflict of Interest Code"), which can be incorporated by reference and which can be amended to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearing conducted by the FPPC pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, Government Code §11370 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners ("Board") of the Yolo Fire Protection District ("District") now desires to adopt the provisions of the Model Conflict of Interest Code for the District.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Yolo Fire Protection District as follows:

1. The terms of the FPPC's Model Conflict of Interest Code (2 California Administrative Code §18730), and any amendments to it duly adopted by the FPPC, together with the attached appendixes, in which officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories set forth, are hereby incorporated by reference and constitute the conflict of interest code of the Yolo Fire Protection District and all its departments and agencies.
2. The Board Secretary is hereby designated as the filing official for statements of economic interest required by the Yolo Fire Protection District's Conflict of Interest Code.
3. Appendix "A" attached hereto constitutes the appendix specifying designated employees in accordance with the Model Conflict of Interest Code. Persons holding designated positions shall file statements of economic interest pursuant to the Model Conflict of Interest Code with the Board Secretary, who shall make an retain a copy and forward the original to the Yolo County Clerk-Recorder who shall be the filing officer and who shall comply with any additional requirements of the FPPC.
4. Appendix "B" attached hereto sets forth the disclosure category for the designated positions.

5. Persons holding designated positions shall include individuals under contract to the extent required by law as determined by the Board of Commissioners. Disclosure Categories shall be as required by law as determined by the Board of Commissioners.
